We offer a comprehensive combination of technical and practical training to prepare you for apprenticeship within the electrical construction industry.

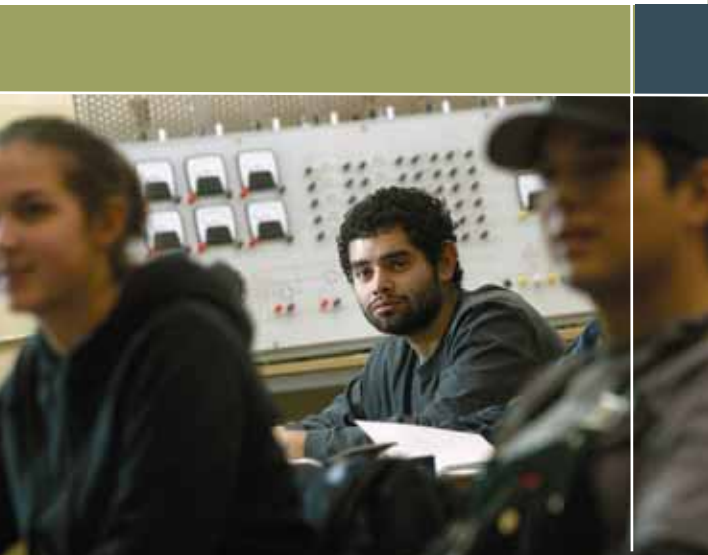
When you join our program, you join a team. We care about our apprentices. You get the most highly-qualified instructors in the electrical training field and the attention you need to do your best.

What is Electrical Entry Level Trades Training (ELTT)?

The ELTT course provides a combination of electrical theory and practical training to prepare you for an apprenticeship in the electrical construction industry.

Participants who successfully complete the course receive a certificate and credit for Level 1 technical training related to the Construction Electrician (Electrical) apprenticeship program.

Topics include electrical theory and code, lockout procedures, forklift certification, fall arrest training, WHMIS, TDG, Confined Space procedures, Hilti shot certification, and rigging.

ELTT is Your Ticket to an Apprenticeship.

IBEW Local 213 Electrical Contractors request graduates from the Electrical ELTT program most often. As a graduate of our Electrical ELTT course, you are given preferred access to EJTC (IBEW L.213) apprenticeships. We select full-time apprenticeship candidates from this program, based on work availability.

The ELTT course is offered three times a year:
January, May and September.

We do not keep a waiting list. Instead we ask interested candidates to apply for the course currently being advertised on our website (www.ejtc.org) and follow the heading under public courses where you can download our application form.

Prerequisites:

English 12, (or equivalent) Principles of Math 11 and Physics 11. Applicants must have all three courses. Please note that you must have all three prerequisites successfully completed at time of application.

Commitment:

The Electrical ELTT course is a full-time course that consists of 15 weeks of technical training at our training facility followed by 10 weeks of paid work experience.

In order to apply for the ELTT course, you must submit the following:

1. A completed application form (available under 'public courses' on our website) or at the EJTC office.
2. A copy of your official secondary school transcript showing prerequisites successfully completed.
3. An up-to-date resume.

After the deadline date, if you have met the prerequisites, you will be contacted about the academic placement exam. We will tell you when the exam is, and what you need to do to prepare for it.

Those who pass the exam will be invited to an interview with Electrical Joint Training Committee representatives, who will then select 16 students for the next ELTT program.
